### ELIGIBILITY

#### Who is Promise for?



*Youth between the ages of 14 and 16 who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) are eligible to participate. Everyone in your household is likely to benefit.*

#### Why should I enroll now?

- Enrollment is limited and ends April 30, 2016.
- Families who participate will receive \$30 in gift cards and have a 50% chance to receive a computer tablet and additional services.
